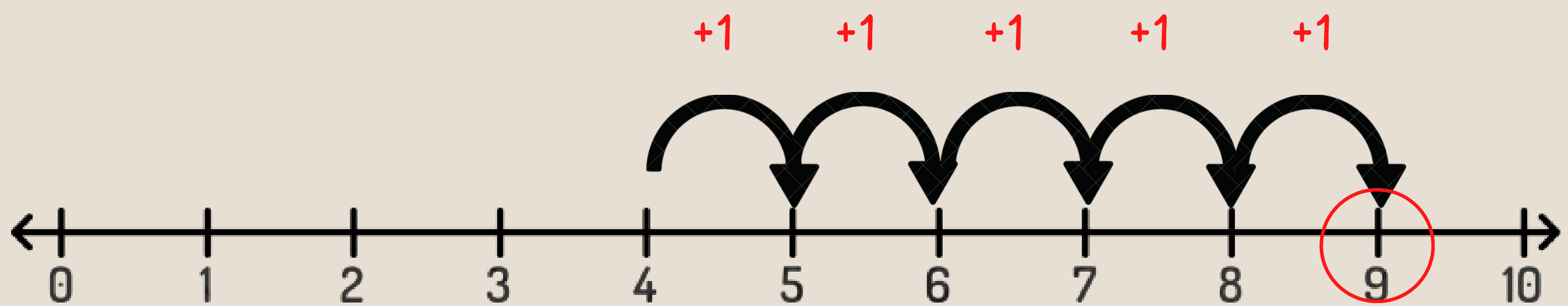

# 1.1 Learn: Using a Number Line to Add from 1-10

You can use this number line to add.

$$4 + 5 = ?$$



Start at 4. Since you are adding, move 5 spaces to the right. Your answer is 9.

1.  $2 + 5 =$

2.  $3 + 7 =$

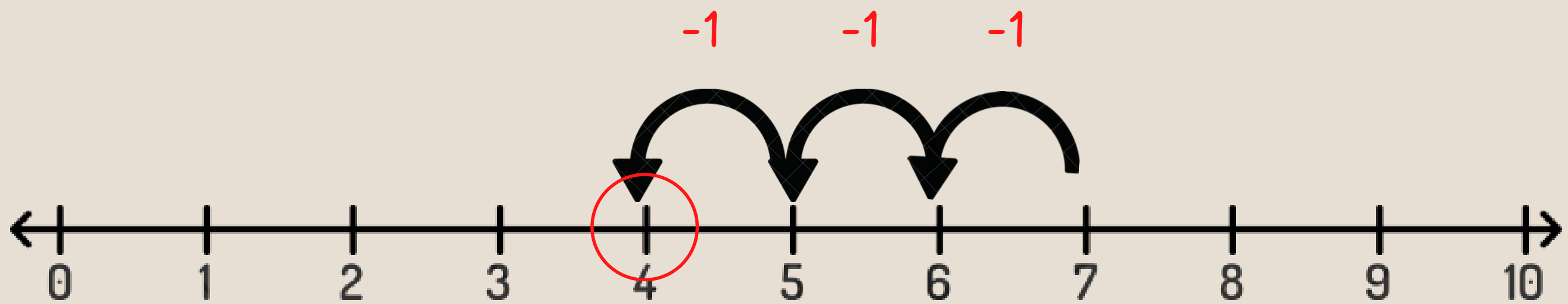
3.  $6 + 3 =$

4.  $5 + 4 =$

# 1.2 Learn: Using a Number Line to Subtract from 1-10

You can use this number line to subtract.

$$7 - 3 = ?$$



Start at 7. Since you are subtracting, move 3 spaces to the left. Your answer is 4.
