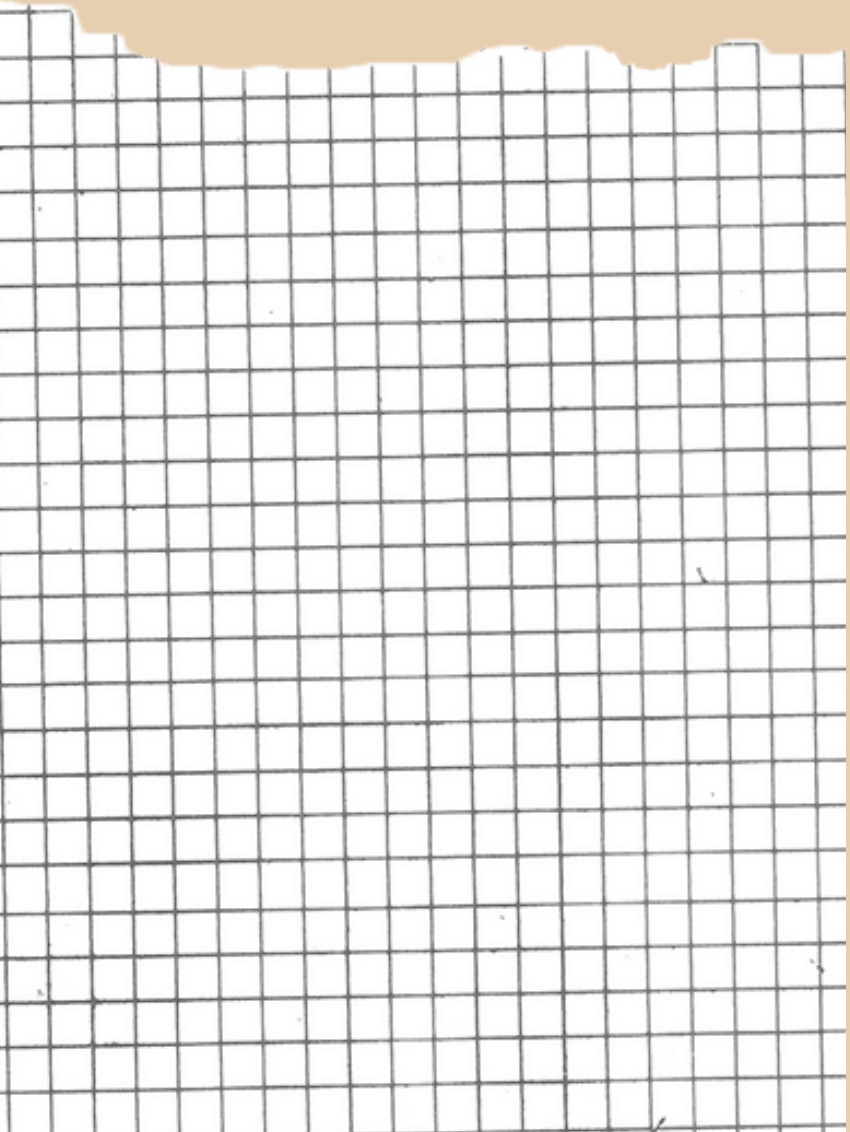

Add the ones place

$$\begin{array}{r} 12 \\ + 36 \\ \hline 8 \end{array}$$

Add the tens place

$$\begin{array}{r} 12 \\ + 36 \\ \hline 4 \end{array}$$

Final Answer!

$$\begin{array}{r} 12 \\ + 36 \\ \hline 48 \end{array}$$

$$\underline{17 + 16 = ?}$$

Using Expanded Form. Start by breaking up numbers based on their place value.

	Add ones and tens based on place value.	Final Answer!
$\begin{array}{r} 17 \\ + 16 \\ \hline \end{array}$	$\begin{array}{r} 10 + 7 \\ 10 + 6 \\ \hline 20 + 13 \end{array}$	$\begin{array}{r} 17 \\ + 16 \\ \hline 33 \end{array}$

$$\underline{36 - 12 = ?}$$

Always start with the numbers on the right, and then move to the left

Subtract the ones place

$$\begin{array}{r} 36 \\ - 12 \\ \hline 4 \end{array}$$

Subtract the tens place

$$\begin{array}{r} 36 \\ - 12 \\ \hline 2 \end{array}$$

Final Answer!

$$\begin{array}{r} 36 \\ - 12 \\ \hline 24 \end{array}$$
